



Lifeguard Job Announcement

Lifeguard Position Overview

This position is responsible for monitoring the pool and pool deck, providing First Aid Response if needed, enforcing the club rules, staffing the snack bar as well as the cleanliness of the facility and locker rooms.

Essential Job Functions

Perform Chemical Checks every two hours or as requested.

In rotation with the additional lifeguards on duty, directly monitor the pool while either walking the deck or sitting in the lifeguard chair. Typically, you are on a guard rotation of 15 minutes at a time.

Complete all accident and incident reports daily, as needed.

Staff the Snack Bar - due to the # of people at the pool, the snack bar may be temporarily closed to allow all guards on duty to monitor the pool for safety.

Walk thru the locker rooms to check for inappropriate behavior and cleanliness

Non-essential Job Functions

Put up and take down the flag.

Remove or Cover the Pool at the end or start of each shift, accordingly. Clean the pool with hand-held skimmers and empty the skimmers.

Wash, dry as needed, and straighten the pool deck furniture and grills.

Maintain the Lost & Found area

Clean Locker Rooms, pool deck and snack bar at the end of each shift and empty all trashcans.

Requirements

The Lifeguard must maintain a professional demeanor at all times; including dress, behavior, attendance, and adhere to Associate Handbook policies.

Must Be 15 years old

Must have current certifications for the following: Red Cross Lifeguard, First Aid, CPR and a Food Handlers Card.

Must be able to lift and carry heavy items up to 50 lbs.

Must be able to stand and sit for up to 1 hour at a time.

All Lifeguards must pass a First Aid/CPR written test with an 80% or better.

All Lifeguards will be required to successfully complete the following during a swim test: swim 500 under 10 minutes; tread water for 2 minutes; retrieve a 5lb brick from the bottom of the pool without resurfacing

Other Skills/Abilities

The Lifeguard needs to be customer service oriented with a can-do attitude.

You need to be authoritative but at the same time polite.

You must be able to work shifts from 7:00am - 10:00pm seven days a week.

All lifeguards will be required to work 1 holiday weekend: Memorial Day, July 4th or Labor Day

Pay: \$19.25 - 25.25 per hour based on experience.
